Arts & Crafts spaces are 12' wide x 10' deep.

Food vendor booths will be set up outside adjoining the Special Event Center. Food Vendor Spaces are 18' x 18'.

Vendors may sell Native American merchandise only. No Asian or other imports, no sage or sweet grass may be sold. The Powwow Committee will enforce these policies and failure to comply may result in expulsion and exclusion from future powwows.

Booth spaces are limited and are assigned on a first received-first assigned system. No electrical outlets are guaranteed.

Booth set-up begins at 11:00 a.m. Friday morning.

The powwow will start at 5:00 PM on Friday, and 11:00 AM on Saturday and Sunday when booths must be set-up.

Coca-Cola is the official beverage sponsor of the Indio Powwow. Vendors may not sell any other brand of soda.

There are no refunds due to lack of sales, theft or other problems out of our control.

Dogs are not allowed in the Special Events Center. Please leave your dogs at home.
